

When was Abkhazia reformed?

So on 19 February 1931 the SSR Abkhazia was reformed as the Abkhaz Autonomous Soviet Socialist Republic, wholly under the control of Georgia, which itself was a constituent republic of the Transcaucasian Socialist Federative Soviet Republic (TSFSR). The downgrading of Abkhazia was not a popular one amongst the Abkhaz population.

When was Abkhazia created?

It came into existence in February 1931, when the Socialist Soviet Republic of Abkhazia (SSR Abkhazia or SSRA), originally created in March 1921, was transformed to the status of Autonomous Soviet Socialist Republic within the Georgian SSR. The Abkhaz ASSR adopted its own constitution on 2 August 1937.

Is Abkhazia a state or a country?

The Government of the Autonomous Republic of Abkhazia[a] is an administration established in exile by Georgia as the de jure government of independent Abkhazia. Abkhazia has been de facto independent from Georgia - though with limited international recognition - since the early 1990s.

When did Abkhazia become a state?

March 1921: The Bolsheviks overthrew the Mensheviks in Georgia. The Abkhazian Soviet Socialist Republic was established independently of Georgia and headed by Nestor Lakoba. 1922: Abkhazia was a signatory to the formation of the USSR acting as a sovereign Abkhazian Republic.

Who represents Abkhazia at UNPO?

Abkhazia is represented at UNPO by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Abkhazia. Government Executive power: President: Alexander Ankvab (since 26 September 2011). The President of the Republic is the head of State and elected for a term of 5 years.

Who is the president of Abkhazia?

The President of the Republic is the head of State and elected for a term of 5 years. Any Abkhaz national who is a citizen of Abkhazia aged from 35 - 65 can be elected President of the Republic of Abkhazia. Elections are based on universal, equal and direct suffrage. The President cannot serve for more than two terms; Vice-president: Mikhail Logua;
