

Did a Singaporean worker fatally electrocuted while installing solar panels?

Singaporean worker fatally electrocuted while installing solar panels. A Singaporean worker was found to be fatally electrocuted during an installation of solar panels on the rooftop of a building on June 12 while working with a group of other staff. The victim died after he noticed and worked on an exposed cable arcing and was emitting smoke.

What happened to Chinese photovoltaic executives at Intersolar Europe?

Some industry insiders said the sudden development reminded them of an incident that happened in 2019, when a number of senior executives of Chinese photovoltaic companies were reportedly taken away by German authorities during the Intersolar Europe exhibition, which sent shockwaves across the industry at that time.

Why are solar companies struggling in China?

Many of China's provinces are struggling to service their debts. Solar companies must also compete for government largesse with firms in other industries that are grappling with overcapacity as China's economy slows. More than a fifth of Chinese industrial firms were unprofitable last year, according to analysis by Rhodium, another consultancy.

Are Chinese solar panels dumping & anti-subsidy?

In 2012, the European Commission initiated investigations into China's solar products. and a year later imposed anti-dumping and anti-subsidy measures on Chinese solar panels, wafers and cells. Chinese manufacturers that sell solar products below the set minimum price are required to pay import duties of up to 64.9 per cent.
