Does a car battery warranty cover a free replacement?

Often, car battery warranties will include three options. They can fall under a free replacement, be pro-rated, or be a combination of the two options. With a pro-rated type of car battery warranty, it will cover a free replacement for the initial phase, and as time goes on, the replacement costs will increase.

How long does a car battery warranty last?

A typical car battery warranty will last approximately two years or up to 240,000 miles. After that time, you may have to pay a portion of the replacement battery costs, depending on the type of warranty it carries. Some manufacturers are moving away from pro-rated warranties and offering 3, 4, or 5-year warranties instead as better alternatives.

The electric car battery warranty can sometimes be overlooked during the purchase process - let's face it, a warranty is not really as glamorous as the paint colour or the heated seats.

Are electric car battery warranties transferable?

Yes, electric car battery warranties in the UK are usually transferable to a new owner, as the warranty tends to be attached to the vehicle itself rather than the individual who purchased it.

The car battery warranty will cover any manufacturer's defects or when it does not hold a full charge. Depending on the type of warranty that comes with the battery, you may receive a complete replacement at no additional cost or pay a portion for a new one.

Should you replace an EV battery out of warranty?
