Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic (SADR),government-in-exileproclaimed by the Polisario Front for self-governance of the disputed territory of Western Sahara. It has been recognized by some 80 countries,though a number of them have withdrawn or suspended recognition.

Who recognizes the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic?

The Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic is recognized by the African Unionand,as of December 2022,by 47 U.N. member states,as well as another de facto state,South Ossetia.

Is the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic a de facto state?

The Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic (SADR) is a unique example of a de facto state- having existed for almost 50 years and enjoying international recognition provided by over forty states. Nevertheless,it controls only one-fifth of the territory it claims rights to,while the rest of it lies within the Moroccan borders.

Who is the president of the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic?

Since August 1982,the highest office of the republic has been the President of the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic,a post held by the secretary-general of the Polisario Front,presently Brahim Ghali,[17]who appoints the Prime Minister,presently Bouchraya Hammoudi Bayoun.

Where did the Saharawi people go after the Madrid Accords?

There is,however,the one: the Saharawi Arab Democratic Republic (SADR). In 1975,after the Madrid Accords,the Moroccan and Mauritanian armed forces seized the territory of the Western Sahara.' The Saharawi people fled from the persecution of the military and found refuge near the town of Tindouf,in Algeria.

The creation of the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic was proclaimed on 27 February 1976,as the Polisario declared the need for a new entity to fill what they considered a political void left by the departing Spanish colonial administration.
