

## How many years of warranty does the new energy battery have for 8 years

How long does a battery energy content degradation warranty last?

No battery energy content degradation warranty exists for 12-volt batteries, 48-volt batteries, or any batteries used in mild hybrid vehicles. For BEVs, the battery energy content degradation warranty lasts for 8 years or up to 100,000 miles, whichever comes first.

Are given energy batteries backed by a warranty?

All GivEnergy batteries and inverters installed and fully commissioned by UK Green Energy Installations will be backed by the 12 year warranty. All systems must be: Fully commissioned and installed by UK Green Energy Installations (a certified GivEnergy Installer). Receive a health check every 5, 8 and 10 year period.

How long does a battery warranty last?

If your battery has a defect or mechanical issue, if it breaks, or experiences unreasonable wear and tear, that's where your product warranty comes into play. Nowadays, most manufacturers offer at least 10 years of coverage under a product warranty, while some premium options have up to 20 years of protection against product defects.

How long does a PHEV battery warranty last?

For PHEVs, the battery energy content degradation warranty lasts for 5 years or up to 100,000 miles, whichever comes first, for the first vehicle owner only. This warranty is not capable of assignment or transfer to subsequent vehicle owners.

Solar battery warranties vary by manufacturer and product. A standard battery warranty should come with at least 10 years of protection, though it can be shorter depending on how often you charge and drain your battery.

Does Volkswagen offer a warranty on electric car batteries?
