Why does my car smoke when it rains?

So long coolant keeps seeping into the engine, the engine will never function properly, putting your engine at risk of overheating. If you notice smoke coming from engine when raining, it is possible that water has come in contact with the exhaust or radiator and is burning off. This shouldn't bother you as it's very normal during the rainy days.

What does it mean if a car smokes from the back?

Smoke from the back of your car means the exhaust is smoking. Smoke coming from the exhaust is an indication you have a blown head gasket, a faulty cylinder, or a cracked engine block that is causing the coolant to burn. If it's a thick white exhaust smoke, it points to a coolant leak, which could cause overheating and serious engine damage.

Why does my car smoke under the hood but not overheating?

There are several reasons why you see smoke under the hood but the car is not overheating. But the simplest explanation is that fluid has landed on a hot engine part, such as the exhaust manifold, and the hot part is burning it off. Below, you will learn other possible reasons for this and how to address the issue.

Why does my car smoke when accelerating?

If it's a thick white exhaust smoke, it points to a coolant leak, which could cause overheating and serious engine damage. If grey smoke comes from the exhaust when accelerating, it's pointing toward a bad PCV valve, excess oil, or transmission fluid leakfor automatic cars.

What causes smoke from an exhaust?

The most common form of smoke from an exhaust isn't actually smoke at all. When a cold engine is started, it soon begins to heat up, and a byproduct of this is water vapour. This creates condensation within the exhaust system, which then turns into steam as temperatures rise within the engine and exits through the exhaust.

Why does my car exhaust smoke while idling?

There are a number of factors that could cause your car exhaust to emit smoke while the car is idling or under acceleration. White smoke or condensation is often emitted when the weather is cold or the car has been sitting in the rain for a period of time.
