

Is the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic a contested state?

1. Introduction The Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic (SADR) claiming the non-self-governing territory of Western Sahara is of such a unique nature as a contested state that it appears stronger in terms of constitutive statehood than of declaratory statehood.

Who is the president of the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic?

Since August 1982, the highest office of the republic has been the President of the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic, a post held by the secretary-general of the Polisario Front, presently Brahim Ghali,<sup>[17]</sup> who appoints the Prime Minister, presently Bouchraya Hammoudi Bayoun.

When was the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic created?

The creation of the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic was proclaimed on 27 February 1976, as the Polisario declared the need for a new entity to fill what they considered a political void left by the departing Spanish colonial administration.

Does Morocco have a right to control Western Sahara?

Morocco's aim has been control of Western Sahara, which it claims as its rightful territory as part of Greater Morocco. Over the years, the international community has preferred to stay silent on the issue.

Does Western Sahara have a 'administering power' box?

Interestingly, Western Sahara is the only territory on the UN list of non-self-governing territories for which the 'administering power' box is vacant.

Does Morocco have a de facto control over Western Saharan resources?

On the other hand, the Moroccan de facto control is reinforced and implicitly legitimated through international economic cooperation with Morocco over Western Saharan resources (fish, phosphates, etc.), including the series of such agreements between Morocco and the EU.
