

How to change a battery on a power2max PowerMeter?

In this Article you can find all the necessary information for changing a battery on your power2max powermeter. Remove the rubber cap that seals the battery. Remove the empty battery. Insert the new battery of Type CR2450. Please ensure the correct polarity. After inserting the battery, the green LED flashes for approximately 120 seconds.

How do I Keep my Power Meter Fresh?

Here's how to keep your power meter as fresh and fit as you! Do not directly spray your power meter with a pressure washer. Cover your power meter to avoid direct contact with any cleaner/degreaser. Some degreasers can cause your battery housing to become brittle.

Do you use a spacer on a pedal based power meter?

The general rule of thumb on pedal-based power meters, especially with pods, is that the pod should never touch the crank arm. So you'll almost always use a single spacer, as I did. I can't remember the last time on any crankset/bike I got away without using one. Then, simply tighten both sides till done. Again, this is silly quick.

How difficult is it to use a power meter?

In power meters today, one of the biggest challenges is outdoor conditions. Generally speaking, indoor conditions are pretty easy to handle, but I still start there nonetheless. It allows me to dig into areas like low and high cadence, as well as just how clean numbers are at steady-state power outputs.

Where is the battery located on the rival AXS power meter?

The AAA lithium battery used by the Rival AXS power meter is user-replaceable and contained within the DUB spindle of the crank assembly, accessible from the non-drive side (left from the riding perspective).
