

# The battery cannot be broken by hand

What happens if a battery is broken?

If it is broken,air will enter and cause the battery to lose charge). Store batteries on racks or on pallets,not on the floor. (Small stones or sharp points on a concrete floor can damage the base of the battery and cause leakage). Make sure handles are left in the flat (down) position. Upright handles are more likely to be damaged.

Is it normal for a battery to fail?

It's very rarefor a battery to just fail,far more normal for their capacity to reduce over time. The worse you treat the battery (like deep discharge),and the older the battery technology,the quicker it will die. Actual instant catastrophic failure really isn't very common at all.

Can a car battery be repaired?

There is no way to repairan individual cell inside most car batteries. You will need to replace the battery. Sometimes the biggest problem with your car's battery is YOU. Frequently starting your vehicle without allowing it to run long enough to recharge the battery will consistently drain the battery.
